Mission and Ministry Description

- F. Be timely in paying Academic Package costs and Annual (or Monthly) Ministry Support.
- G. Adhere to State Requirements for homeschool student enrollment.
- H. Admission to K5: Students must be five years old on or before 9/1/2019 and fully restroom trained at the time of enrollment.
