## Mission and Ministry Description

Lighthouse Ministry (LHM) of Calvary Chapel Miami purposes to honor and to worship our Savior Jesus Christ by providing an excellent education, by training up students in the knowledge of God, and by developing their Christian character in a safe and loving environment.

LHM is a Christ-filled learning center for families who were called to invest in the spiritual and educational development of their children. The school program currently offers preschool through 12th grade with a fully accredited curriculum and extra-curricular enrichment. - D. Receive Lighthouse Ministry Acceptance Letter.
- E. Attend the new family and student(s) enrollment meeting with Administration.
- F. Be timely in paying Academic Package costs and Annual (or Monthly) Ministry Support.
- H. Admission to PreK: Students must be at least 3 years and old by first day of school fully restroom-trained and self-sufficient in hygiene after restroom use at the time of enrollment.
